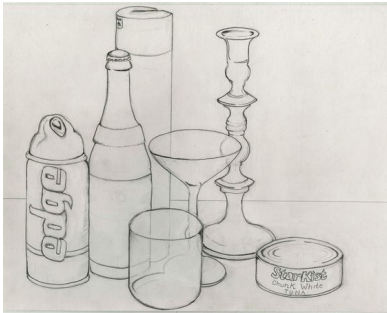


Art Choice Board

GRADES 4th, 5th, and 6th:

Gather 3-5 objects around the house and arrange them. Create an outline or "contour" design by drawing them.



Create a face by cutting out eyes, nose and mouths from magazines and arranging them.



Create a comic showing a beginning, a middle, and an end. Also create a set of creative characters and title your comic.



Draw a portrait of someone around the house, or even a pet! Include the name of the person or pet in your work.



Gather rocks, sticks, and leaves around your yard and incorporate them in your artwork!

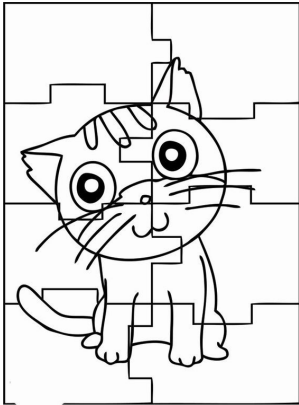


Go outside and choose a quiet space to sit and draw the same picture two times—once in the morning, once in the evening.



Grade K-3rd

Create a drawing a simple drawing (a heart, a flower, a rainbow, etc.) and then cut it up into squares (not too small). Have someone try and assemble the puzzle!



**Cut out images of magazines or newspapers and assemble to create a new picture!
Draw to add more to your picture and color!**



Gather rocks and sticks in the yard to create a face using the natural objects. Take a picture or glue to the page.



Trace 5-6 circles from objects you can find in your home. Color them using many different patterns, colors, and lines.



Draw a picture of your family. Make sure to label them and include your pets.

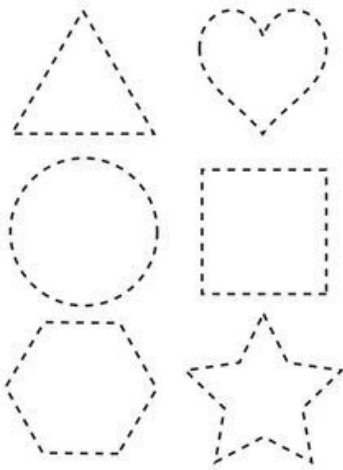


Build a castle out of blocks or legos. Take a picture or try and draw your creation!

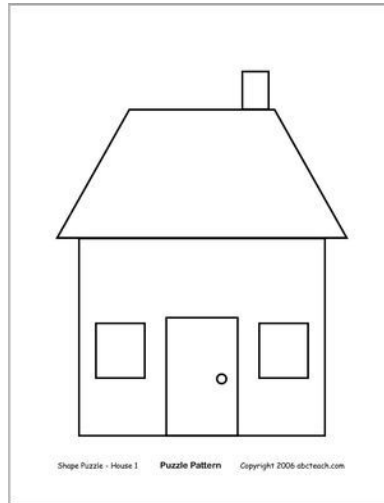


PreK

Draw a house using simple shapes and then color. You can use blocks to trace the shapes and other household items!



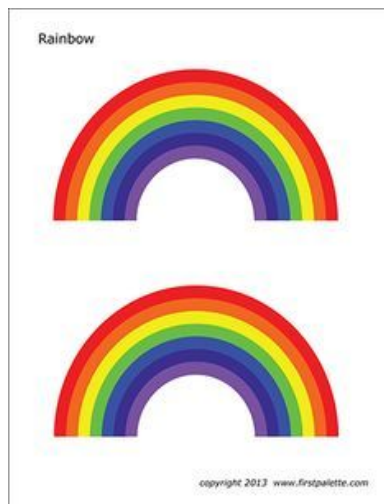
Draw a picture of you and your family. Color the picture and ask an adult to help you label.
